Registration Names/Numbers on Websites - Final Notice

In November we announced that as of 1/1/11, all breeder members must have their dogs' ALAA registered names and ALAA registration numbers on their websites. We appreciate everyone's compliance on this. When only call names of dogs appear on websites, it is very difficult for us to match call names with registered names for audit purposes.

There are still some breeders who are not in compliance, so we are extending the deadline to 2/1/11.

As of 2/1/11, breeders who are not in compliance with this rule will have their breeder listing removed from the ALAA's member breeders page until their website is brought into compliance.

Thank you for your understanding on this very important issue.

Use of Labradoodles in Other Breeds

Effective 3/1/11, ALAA Breeder Members will not be allowed to use their ALAA registered kennel website to market North American Retrievers, Double Doodles, or any other breed in which a Labradoodle or Australian Labradoodle is used as the sire or dam.

Any dogs that were previously de-registered for use in NAR, DD, or other program are eligible for re-registration under the current registration guidelines with current health testing, etc.
