

## What is the ALAA?

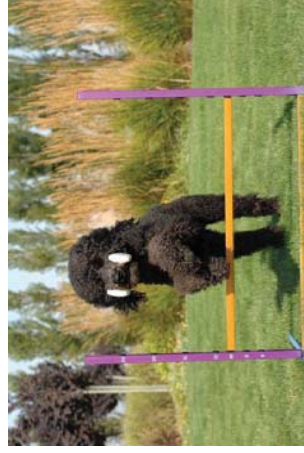
