



## Infusion Cockapoo Registration Application Form Outline

The requirements for developing new bloodlines of Australian Labradoodles are set out as follows:

### Breeder Requirements:

Apply to Cockapoo Owners and Breeders who hire a Cockapoo with the intent to produce infusion litters.

- (1) You must have no less than 18 months of prior ALAA accredited breeder membership before undertaking a parent breed infusion mating/application.
- (2) You must have bred no less than four litters of **Australian Labradoodles** under the ALAA.
- (3) Breeder must agree to desex all pet puppies produced in an infusion litter prior to leaving breeder's property. No spay/neuter contracts will be allowed on infusion litters.

### Infusion Cockapoo Registration Application Form Part I(a):

To be completed within 30 days of purchasing said dog.

- (1) Fill out Parent Breed Infusion Application Part I
- (2) Pay \$25 Application fee.
- (3) Photos standing both front and side
- (4) Permanent identification
- (5) Pedigree (must be pure breed AKC provable)

### Infusion Cockapoo Registration Application From Part I(b):

To be submitted prior to breeding said dog.

- (1) Fill out Parent Breed Infusion Application Part II
- (2) Hip testing
- (3) Elbow testing
- (4) OFA patella
- (5) CERF exam
- (6) vWD
- (7) OFA Thyroid testing every 18 months
- (8) PRA prcd testing
- (9) Height and weight (current photos if originals were sent in as a puppy)

### Breeding Pair Approval Form Part II:

**Note:** Applies to all breeding pairs and must be submitted by Litter Owner (person responsible for registering the litter). Does NOT apply to repeat breedings previously submitted and approved. Repeat breedings are still subject to health testing standards and current health test results must be submitted prior to registration.

- (1) Fill out Parent Breed Infusion Application Part II
- (2) Turn in all health testing, pedigree, and photos of desired breeding pair.

### The following will be required on the litter and must be submitted for registration to be completed:

- (1) Register litter
- (2) Permanent ID (tattoo or microchip) on all puppies in the litter
- (3) Only three (3) breeding dogs may be retained from a litter and all others must be desexed prior to leaving breeder's property
- (4) Desex Certificates for remainder of the litter, (Prior to leaving breeders property)

### NOTE:

Any breeder who breeds a parent breed infusion without meeting the above requirements and approval of their application will have the litter rejected for registration & inclusion in the Australian Labradoodle breed and will be subject to disciplinary actions. The penalty for noncompliance with any of the above requirements will be a \$400 fine and mandatory desexing of the entire litter.
